Global Dialogue for Sustainable Transport: National Pathways and Transport Actions

Friday, 6 December 2019 13:45 - 15:15 Chilean Pavilion (Blue Zone)

Description

Climate change cannot be stopped without decarbonising transport. Transport emits around 24 percent of the energy-related carbon dioxide (CO_2) and transport emissions are growing faster than any other sector over the past 50 years. Without immediate action, its share could reach 40 percent by 2030 and 60 percent by 2050.

The transport sector needs more ambitious actions to help advance the goals of the Paris Agreement and to engage non-Parties stakeholders in the process. This event will introduce the International Transport Forum's (ITF) Decarbonising Transport initiative, which was created in 2016 to help governments and industry translate climate ambitions into actions, and to highlight key outputs. Together with the Ministry of Environment in Chile and the Chilean Generators (SOFOFA), this event will serve as a platform to foster an inclusive policy dialogue with key stakeholders and partners and to showcase national pathways and specific mitigation actions for transport, such as electro-mobility.

Format

This event will consist of presentations followed by a discussion with the audience. Each speaker will have 10 minutes for their presentation.
